

EXPLANATION OF THE GAME **
SPIELERKLÄRUNG =

Texas Hold'em Poker



Each player is dealt two cards face down, which only he/she may see and use. Then, five community cards are dealt one after the other, which all players can see and use. The players put together their five-card hands from both, one or none of their face-down cards in combination with the community cards.

The game is broken down into four rounds, and the players bet one after the other in clockwise fashion. The first player to bet is the one who sits next to the dealer button (dealer), which shifts one position to the left after each round.

Blinds

Before the game begins, the two players to the left of the dealer place the specified bets, known as blinds. The name comes from the fact that the players post them without having first seen their cards. The blinds ensure that there is money in the pot so that the game can be played for it. The player to the left of the dealer posts the small blind (often one-half of the big blind), and the player to the left of him/her posts the big blind. Preflop blinds are forced bets that the two players positioned at the table next to the dealer are required to make.

First round - flop

Next, the player sitting after the blinds, i.e. the neighbour to the left of the big blind, is up. He/ she can call (match the amount of the big blind), raise (wager at least double the amount of the big blind) or fold (leave the round). Consider carefully whether your cards are good enough to play the round or whether it's better to save your bet and instead play in a later round.

Next, all players make their bets one after the other until the bets are completely balanced, i.e. all players who wish to remain in the game have bet the same amount. It is also possible for a raise to be met with a re-raise, i.e. a player who has already raised is out-bet by a subsequent player and is forced to match the latter's bet in order to remain in the game. Once all players have made their bets and matched the highest raise, three cards are dealt face up in the middle of the table. This is known as the flop.

Second round - turn

The bets previously made by the players at the table are pushed into the middle of the table and form what is known as the pot, which is at stake in the round. After the flop is dealt, there is another round of betting, which now starts with the player sitting to the left of the dealer. Players who have folded do not take part. Also in the second round, you now have the ability to check, bet, call, or raise or re-raise or fold. When the players have either matched the highest bet by a player or folded, the fourth community card is dealt face up into the middle, known as the turn.

Third round - river

Next, the game proceeds as before. The player among those remaining who is sitting closest to the left of the dealer starts and has the option to check or bet. Depending on what he/she decides, all subsequent players have the option to check, bet, raise or fold. If all bets are balanced and two or more players are still in the game, the fifth card, known as the river, is dealt into the middle.

Fourth round - showdown

After the river, there is also another round of betting as described in the previous steps. If several players are still in the game after betting, a showdown takes place. One after the other, all remaining players must turn over their two face-down cards, and the best poker hand wins. The winner takes the entire pot, i.e. all bets that have accumulated in the middle over the course of the round. If there is a tie, the pot is split equally between the players with the best hand.

Payouts

In the event of disputes, the final decision is made by management.
